Offered by Senator Aldo A. DeAngelis

WHEREAS, Leo Goodman-Malamuth II, the president of Governors State University in University Park, Illinois, will retire in August of 1992, after 16 years of outstanding service to the institution; and

WHEREAS, President Leo Goodman-Malamuth has overseen a period of major growth in student population and of subsequent revisions in the academic structure and course offerings of the university; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Leo Goodman-Malamuth has bachelor of arts, master of arts, and doctor of philosophy degrees from the University of Southern California; and

WHEREAS, Before becoming President of Governors State, he served for 20 years as a faculty member and academic administrator at California State University, Long Beach; and

WHEREAS, He is the senior president among executives of public universities in Illinois, and has served on numerous boards, including those of the Chicago Metropolitan Higher Education Council and The Union Institute, as a member and president of the American Association of University Administrators, as a member and chairman of the Committee on Technology in Education and the Committee of Upper Level Universities of the American Association of State Colleges and Universities, and as a member of the board of directors of South Suburban Hospital, Y-Me, and Firststar Park Forest Bank; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Leo Goodman-Malamuth II has served the State of Illinois as an outstanding educator and civic leader; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we congratulate Dr. Leo Goodman-Malamuth II on 16 years of distinguished service as President of Governors State University, commend him for the farsighted leadership he has provided to the university and for his dedication to excellence in education, and wish him and his wife, Margaret, all the best in the future; and be it further

RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this preamble and resolution be presented to Dr. Leo Goodman-Malamuth II.
