The Dr. Gerald C. Baysore Endowed Distinguished Service Award

The purpose of this award is to honor the memory of Associate Vice President of Academic Affairs, Dr. Gerald C. Baysore, who died October 17, 1988, by rewarding that Governors State University employee who in the judgment of the University President, during the year in question, most fully embodied the following four qualities so consistently and fully embodied by Dr. Baysore during his eighteen-year service of the university:

1. absolute integrity
2. total competence
3. generous dedication
4. unflinching civility

Each year the Deans and Vice Presidents will be asked to nominate one individual only from their respective jurisdictions. The nominations must be based on the four qualities named above. Letters of support from individuals other than the Dean may, but need not accompany the nomination.

From these nominations the university President will, in consultation with Mrs. Gerald S. Baysore, select the winner.

It is understood that, as the endowment grows, funds will be available to make more than one award per year. For the first ten years of the endowed fund, the award(s) may far exceed but may never fall below \$500. In 1998 and each subsequent ten years, the Directors of the Foundation shall have the right to raise the minimum amount awarded.

It is understood that Mrs. Gerald Baysore will keep the Foundation informed as to her address. It is further understood that, when Mrs. Baysore is no longer able to participate in the selection process, the son of Dr. and Mrs. Gerald C. Baysore, Mr. Mark Baysore, will be consulted annually by the University President and that Mr. Baysore will keep the Foundation informed as to his address. When Mr. Mark Baysore is no
