

Reading Tutorial Program Available

GSU's Graduate Program in Reading is sponsoring *The Literacy Zone*, a reading tutorial program for students in grades six through high school, on Tuesdays, from February 1 through April 26, from 4:45 to 6:30 p.m. This 12-week, one-to-one program brings students experiencing reading problems together with teachers who have the skills to help them.
