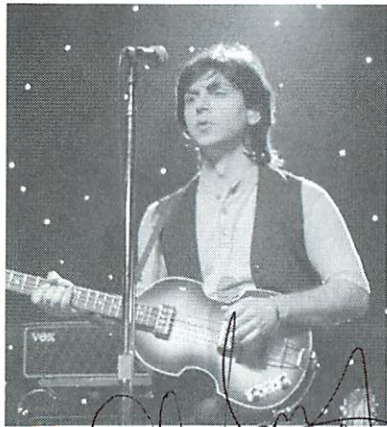


The Fab Four™

ARDY SARRAF as Paul McCartney

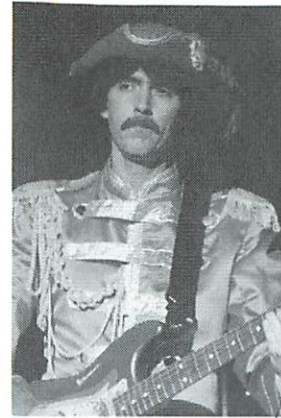

Steve never believed he'd get the chance to portray Lennon, and is currently living out the dream with The Fab Four in their Las Vegas show, FabFourMania. With amazing vocals and talent on the guitar, bass, keyboard, and harmonica, Steve will make you believe the late legend is really on-stage.

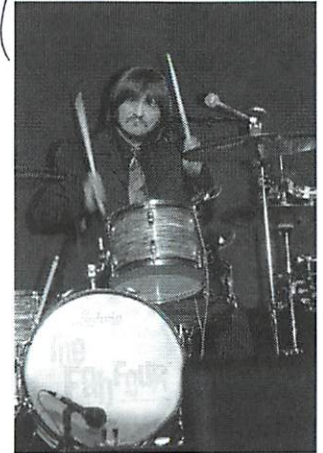


GAVIN LESLIE as George Harrison

Born and raised in Liverpool, England, Gavin has been playing the role of George Harrison for about 4 years. He originally played the drums at the age of 16, but after an injury that left him hospitalized, he decided to take up guitar. Gavin had the honor of performing on-stage with Paul McCartney during Harrison's birthday tribute in 2002. There has never been a more accurate portrayal of the quiet Beatle. His remarkable resemblance and amazing George mannerisms keep audiences coming back.

ROLO SANDOVAL as Ringo Starr

Rolo began portraying Ringo Starr when he was nineteen years old. Known as the most solid drummer in the Beatle business, he has played around the world with the groups Beatlemania, Twist and Shout, Revolver, and Classical Mystery Tour featuring a 41 piece orchestra. Rolo's limitless talent gives him the ability to duplicate Ringo's trademark sound. This climaxes with his performance of "Yellow Submarine" in which he gets the whole audience to participate by clapping and singing along.
