<a href="#">Font and Typeface Guidelines</a>		The Pringle Memorial Scholarship is named for Robert Pringle who helped create the original Board of Governors degree program from which the School of Interdisciplinary Learning has evolved. The Pringle family administers the scholarship through an endowment.					
<a href="#">Editorial Style Guide</a>		The School of Interdisciplinary Learning offers college credit based on learning gleaned from life experiences. It was created for students like Mattox with work and life experience equivalent, in many cases, to college level work. Students in the program complete degree requirements within the program, often tailoring undergraduate studies in preparation for graduate work.					
<a href="#">Downloads</a>		“We are very proud of Linda,” said Michele McMaster, Director of the School of Interdisciplinary Learning. “Students in our program are very determined to earn their degrees and scholarship opportunities like this help make it possible.”
