Maimon announced today that Joan Vaughan, a Governors State University alumna, has been appointed Vice President of Institutional Advancement and Chief Executive Officer of the Governors State University Foundation effective January 7, 2008.

She will design and implement annual giving programs that will support GSU initiatives such as the GSU Promise, a program guaranteeing a debt-free bachelor's degree education from GSU for community college graduates from low-income families. She will also help develop the university's relationship with its alumni through expanded outreach programs, activities, and community events.

Previous development assignments included positions at Northwestern University, Feinberg School of Medicine; University of Illinois at Chicago, College of Urban Planning and Public Administration; American Association of Neurological Surgeons; the Orthopedic Research and Education Foundation; and the Illinois Chapter of the Lupus Foundation of America.
