



Using the Map of Meaningful work to analyze podcasting in higher education provided a sense of purpose for publishing non-juried content.

The significance of this research is the application of a new methodology for exploring meaning in educational research as well as the revival of self in being part of something bigger.

Publication (70 episodes)


Write objective summary show notes with links to referenced material
