Pia Sebastiani, Argentine-born pianist and artist-in-residence at Ball State University, will be the guest artist on Sunday, Feb. 8, when the GSU Foundation presents the Governors State University String Quartet in a free concert at 4:00 p.m. in the Music Recital Hall.

The Quartet will open the program with Beethoven's String Quartet in F Major, Op. 59, No. 1, subtitled Rasumovsky. Ms. Sebastiani will join them in the Concerto for Violin, Piano and String Quartet in D Major, Op. 21, by Ernest Chausson. Dr. Francois D'Albert, leader of the Quartet, will be featured violin soloist.
