## President Maimon announces reorganization of student affairs and support services

In a memorandum to the GSU community, President Elaine P. Maimon announced the consolidation of all enrollment management and student support functions and services under a single, unified Division of Student Affairs. "This new organizational structure," said Maimon, "provides a seamless pathway for students from first inquiry about GSU to certification for graduation." It in fact reflects GSU's evolution into a full-service, comprehensive university, she added.

Dr. Aurelio Valente, appointed as Interim Vice President of Student Affairs, will lead the Division. He will continue to report to Provost Deborah Bordelon.

Valente brings broad-based experience and enthusiasm to this new role. "It has been a true pleasure to work with the talented and dedicated professionals in Enrollment Management as a Student Affairs partner. I am humbled at the opportunity to serve the university in this expanded capacity and to be able to work with the same very talented and dedicated team in serving our students with an increased level of collaboration and a shared sense of focus and commitment to growing enrollment and enhancing student success."

Reporting to Dr. Valente, Associate Vice President Randi Schneider, who has provided distinguished leadership of the Dual Degree Program (DDP), will now assume leadership responsibility for Enrollment Management. "I am confident this structural integration will serve us well as we look at FC14 and beyond. This is an extraordinary opportunity and I am humbled to have been asked to serve GSU in this capacity."
