UNIVERSITY ASSEMBLY...At its meeting September 21, the University Assembly passed a number of SCEPP proposals including...a statement of general objectives and policies relating to junior college relations...a lengthy statement relating to registration and student information systems guaranteeing confidentiality of a student's record and specifying those parts of the student's record that can be released as a public record (name, college, area of study, dates student attended GSU, degree, graduation date and honors) while indicating elements to be included in the GSU student record and methods of use...a resolution that credits be awarded only after completion of all registration requirements and that failure to complete registration will remove students from the roles of learning modules and future enrollments until requirements are met including prior financial indebtedness...clarifying statement on overloads which effectively allows a student up to 16 "active" (not completed) units before requiring special permission for an overload.

Also considered, but recommitted back to the Governance Committee was a proposed Constitutional Amendment that would expel Assembly representatives who miss three consecutive regularly scheduled Assembly meetings or a total of five during any term of office...referred to the Human Services Committee the matter of possible University responses to discrimination against University staff and students.
