THEATRE DEBUT... Tickets for GSU's first theatre production, "The Marriage-Go-Round" may now be reserved by staff and students by calling CCS at extension 324. The Leslie Stevens' play will be presented on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday, November 9, 10, and 11, at 8:00 p.m. in the Commons. Money purchases of tickets can be handled directly through the Cashier, Monday through Saturday. Students must present an ID card in CCS to receive a free ticket. General Admission tickets for staff are set at \$2.00 each. GERRY STEPHENS, a graduate student in CCS will act as Assistant Director, with DAVE REEVE of CCS designing and building the sets.

The play is an illustrated lecture on the perils of monogamy, delivered alternately by a Professor of Cultural Anthropology at a suburban New York College, and his wife, who is the Dean of Women at the same school. The cast of the play now in rehearsal includes TIM ZITO, CCS graduate student, ELAINE STRAUSS of Communications and a graduate student in CHLD, and two non-students, CHARLES WADDINGTON and KATHLEEN CHAPMAN.

The "Marriage-Go-Round" is the first of six tentatively scheduled theatre experiences that include two workshop presentations, a children's theatre production and two other major productions. Students and Staff are urged to get their tickets early.

CHLD OPEN FORUM... scheduled from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. every Friday in the Dean's area of CHLD. These open discussions, it is hoped, will be attended by students and faculty with questions that require answers.

CCS ANNOUNCES... its administrative office will now be open until 7:00 p.m. every Tuesday and Thursday. Faculty and secretarial staff will be available for assistance to evening students.

GWENDOLYN BROOKS... will present a free public program Friday, November 3, at 6:00 p.m. in the Commons. Miss Brooks, the Poet Laureate of Illinois and Pulitzer prize-winning poet, is the author of nine books, holder of 12 honorary doctorates, and winner of 14 awards for her writing. Miss Brooks has lectured and conducted poetry seminars at colleges and universities all over the United States. "The World of Gwendolyn Brooks" is a new book demonstrating her dedication to her community and nation. "To Gwen With Love" is a book as a tribute from the Black community of writers and poets. She is the editor of a new magazine, "The Black Position."

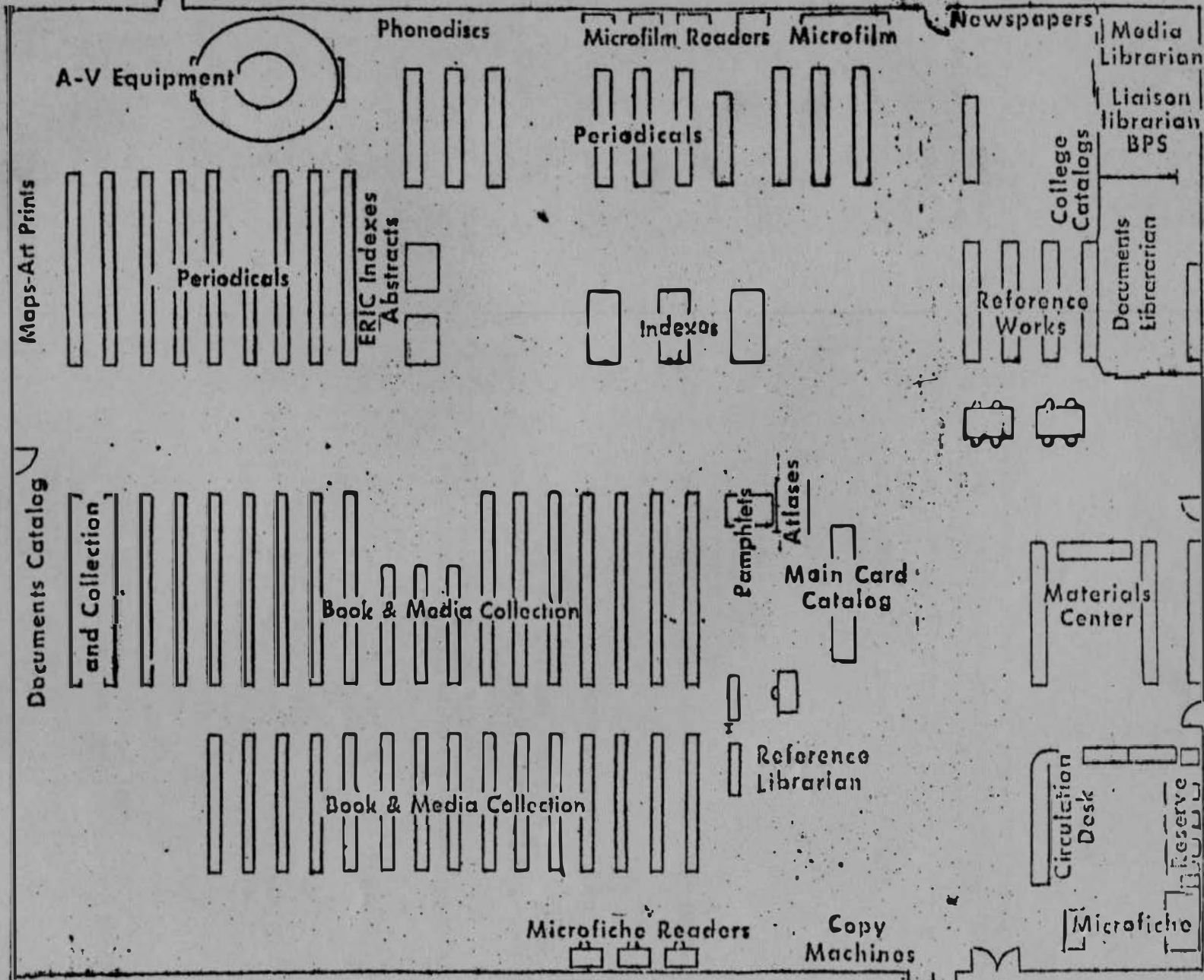
