All travel vouchers for travel beginning July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009 must be submitted to the Financial Services and Comptroller's Office by July 14 in order to receive reimbursement for your FY 2009 travel.

For travel beginning July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009, use the FY 2009 travel voucher.

For travel beginning July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010, use the FY 2010 travel voucher. All FY 2010 travel vouchers should reflect the new mileage rate of \$0.55 per mile.
